LONG RANGE HIGHPOWER RIFLE MATCH

November 19-20, December 10-11, 2005, January 7-8, 2006

LOCATION: Rifle Range 13, Camp Robinson, AR. Camp Robinson is located two miles north of Interstate 40. Use Burns Park exit 150, three miles west of the I-30, I-40 interchange. Drivers license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance will be required to receive a pass at the entrance to the base.

TIME: ENTRIES CLOSE AT 0715 HRS. FIRING WILL COMMENCE AT 0800 HRS EACH DAY.

RULES: This is a NRA approved event. NRA rules will govern throughout the tournament. A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge per rule 16.1.

ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be NRA members. NRA memberships will be available at the range.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fee for either day's competition is \$25 for club members and \$30 for non-members. Entry fee for both days is \$45 for club members and \$50 for non-members. (Juniors – ladies: \$10 for 1 day, \$20 for 2 days). Entries will be limited to 80 shooters. These fees include \$4.50 NRA fee and National Guard range fee.

SQUADDING & CLASSIFICATION: Squadding tickets will be issued at the stat trailer. The NRA classification system including assigned classification rule 19.6 will be used. If there are less than three competitors in a class, they will be moved to a higher class. No one will be moved to the High Master class. Only iron sight scores will be sent to the NRA.

TARGETS, RIFLES & SIGHTS: 600 yard MR-1 targets. Service Rifle Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2. Match rifle rules 3.2, 3.3, 3.3.1, 3.3.2, 3.3.3. Rule 9.1 will only apply to the Service rifle class. Case capacity 30-06 maximum.

COURSE OF FIRE & SCHEDULE: Match 1-5 will be fired on the first day. Match 6 on the second day.

Match 1 - 20 shots prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes. Iron sights.

Match 2 - 20 shots prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes. Iron sights.

Match 3 - 20 shots prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes. Any sights.

Match 4 - 20 shots prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes. Any sights.

Match 5 - Aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

Match

6 - Aggregate of four 20 shot strings prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes.

2 strings iron sights - 2 strings any sights.

AWARDS: In matches 1-5 there will be a winner, a first in each class, a second if there are 7-12 shooters in that class, a third if there are 13 or more. Winners will receive trophies or award points. High jr. and High Lady in match 5 will receive awards. In match 6 there will be a winner and a first in each class. Competitors may receive only one award per match. If ten or more competitors are shooting Service Rifles they will form a class and compete for awards in their class.

SAFETY: Clear chamber indicators are required at all CAGC events and will be available for \$2.00 each. Competitors and spectators are urged to wear eye and hearing protection when appropriate.

2006 ARKANSAS REGIONAL HIGH POWER RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

**Central Arkansas Gun Club
September 30 and October 1, 2006**

GENERAL INFORMATION: Saturday an 800 point Regional Match competition will determine the 2006 Arkansas Regional Champion. Sunday a 4 man teams will contest a Presidents match course, followed by a Civilian Marksmanship Program **LEG** match.

LOCATION: Rifle Range 13, Camp Robinson, AR. Camp Robinson is located 2 miles north of I-40. Use Burns Park exit 150, three miles west of the I-30, I-40 interchange. Competitors will be required to stop at the base entrance to get a pass. Drivers license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance will be checked. This will take five to twenty minutes depending on traffic so allow time for it. Detailed directions are available if you need them.

RULES: This is a NRA registered events. Current NRA and CMP rules will govern throughout the tournament.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA. NRA memberships will be available at the range.

ENTRIES: **ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.** You must **sign in at the stat trailer and entries will close at 07:15 each day!** Firing is limited to 80 competitors. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE REGISTRATION CARD FOR A VALID ENTRY.**

ENTRY FEES: Saturday: Club member \$35, Non-member \$40, Junior and Ladies \$20
Sunday: Team match \$20 per team. Leg match \$15.

Entry fees include \$5.50 NRA registration and National Guard range use fees. In the event the competitor does not fire, all entry fees except the NRA registration fee will be refunded. Send check, money order or award points for fees.

SCORING/PITS: Competitors will score and operate targets. Any competitor failing to report for assigned pit duty when scheduled will be subject to disqualification.

CLASSIFICATION: The appropriate NRA classification system will be used in each match. Unclassified shooters will shoot in the Master class unless assigned a classification per rule 19.6.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done using shooter classifications for all shooters pre-entered. Post entries will be squadded in the order received. In the Regional Match championship, competitors will fire, both their standing and sitting matches, without leaving the firing line. Rule 11.6.7.b will not apply. Squadding tickets will be issued behind the 600-yard line at the stat trailer each day. NRA membership and classification cards must be presented before tickets will be issued. Any competitor who is not present at the proper firing point when called may lose the right to compete in that event.

RIFLES & SIGHTS: All matches: Service Rifle rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3
RMC: Match Rifle rules 3.3, 3.3.1, 3.3.2
Leg match: Service rifles per CMP rules

TARGETS: 200 yds - SR; 300 yds - SR3; 600 yds - MR1.

CATAGORIES AND CLASSES: Classes will be divided into additional categories of match rifle and service rifle if five or more of each category are shooting in that class. All entry cards must show any special awards the shooter is eligible for.

SAFETY: Open bolt/empty chamber indicators are required at all CAGC events and will be available for \$2.00 each. Competitors and spectators are urged to wear eye and hearing protection when appropriate.

GENERAL: There will be no break for lunch. Water and facilities will be available on the range.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fee for either day's competition is \$25 for club members and \$30 for non-members. Entry fee for both days is \$45 for club members and \$50 for non-members. (Juniors - ladies pay \$10 one day - \$20 two days). Entries will be limited to 80 shooters. These fees include \$4.50 NRA fee and National Guard range fee.

SQUADDING & CLASSIFICATION: Squadding tickets will be issued behind the 600-yard line at the stat trailer. The NRA classification system including assigned classification rule 19.6 will be used. If there are less than three competitors in a class, they will be moved to a higher class. No one will be moved to the High Master class. Participation and other factors will determine the relay and pit assignments.

RIFLES & SIGHTS: NRA Match Rifle or Service Rifle, metallic sights only. (Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2 and 3.3.)

COURSE OF FIRE & SCHEDULE: Match 1-5 will be fired on Saturday. Match 6 will be fired on Sunday.

Match 1 - 20 shots standing, 200 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes.

Match 2 - 20 shots standing to sitting, 200 yds, RF, 2 sighters, 60 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 3 - 20 shots standing to prone, 300 yds, RF, 2 sighters, 70 seconds per 10 shot string.

Match 4 - 20 shots prone, 600 yds, SF, 2 sighters, 22 minutes.

Match 5 - Aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

Match 6 - 800 - point Regional Match.

TARGETS: 200 yards – SR; 300 yards – SR-3; 600 yards - MR-1.

AWARDS: In matches 1-5 there will be a winner, a first in each class, a second if there are 7-12 shooters in that class, a third if there are 13 or more. Winners will receive trophies or award points. High jr. and high lady in match 5 will receive awards. In match 6 there will be a winner and a first in each class.
